Paulene Mae (Edghill) Bremer, 92 years young, of Imperial passed away peacefully Sunday, January 31st, 2016, at Eben-Ezer Lutheran Care Center in Brush, Colorado. Paulene was born June 21st, 1923, at her parents' home in Franklin, Nebraska, to Harold Roland and Mary Gladys (Houseman) Edghill, they moved to Palisade in 1928. She graduated from Palisade High School in 1940.

Paulene met her love, Duane Arol Bremer, on a blind date in May of 1940. They were engaged in June of 1940 and married on July 26th, 1940. The couple had 42 years to share together. They made their home at Ben L. & Mayme (Blanke) Bremer's while Duane enlisted into the Marines.
